Working with Vision

When you don't write anything, that's when it's a problem. When you write it down, God starts talking to your heart. When you get it you'll see it needs some tweaking. Rhema knowledge (revelation knowledge) Eph. 2:8.

If you chose the Lord by works you would have a problem right now. The Spirit moves where He wills. Phi. 4:6, 7, don't worry. Worry isn't something a Christian is supposed to do.

I've learned to cast my cares on Him. Though I'm not perfect, I worry a lot less than I used to. When worry starts to creep up I'm quicker at recognizing it and casting it away. I depend on scriptures and God's promises to get me through my rough patches.

Left hemisphere – logic, math; gears right-handed; more artistic.

Right hemisphere – concepts, directions

Your mind can help you or get in the way. In Christ you should be balanced and God will quicken your mind. God wants to use your mind but don't let it get in the way when writing the vision. Pray and fast – helps a lot and the Spirit will help. We are children of Rhema knowledge.

"Meditate" in Hebrew means to mutter, to say it; it becomes revelatory – it goes from head knowledge down to your spirit and the Spirit of God reveals something to you.

There is a mental process but you have to be careful. Gift of prophecy was given to Israel, to the Jews but they were disobedient.
